

RISERVA LA VENARIA REALE

“Riserva La Venaria Reale” is the vermouth created to establish a milestone in the “Riserva” category of classic Italian vermouths.

A vermouth in the style of the former kingdom of Piemonte, this bottling is a result of a unique partnership between Cocchi and the royal *Reggia di Venaria*. Only two very limited editions have been produced since 2016, making them rare and collectible bottles.

Recipe, selection of botanicals, long maturation: every element has been carefully reasoned and selected for historical and geographical consistency.

Cocchi Vermouth Riserva La Venaria Reale has, in fact, a strong local identity - Piedmontese wine, herbs from the Alps - and historical identity, recalling the essential role played by the House of Savoy in the diffusion of the modern Vermouth.

Characteristics

The Cocchi Riserva La Venaria Reale is the pinnacle of decades of researches and experiences in historical vermouth’s production.

The signature Cocchi style makes this unique vermouth identifiable for its strong personality, for the intensity of floral freshness and spicy fragrances and for the complexity of flavours.

After a precise blend of selected ingredients, each bottle is laid in the darkness for more than six months to let the elements perfectly marry together.

We chose not to age our Riserva in barrels, which would affect the complex aromatic balance in favour of oxidation and tannin components.

As for Cocchi Storico Vermouth di Torino, the wine is aromatized with a formula particularity rich in Artemisia, Rhubarb, Alpine herbs and a touch of Piedmontese mint. This composition accentuates the pleasant balsamic notes and gives a surprising freshness, still very intense even when mixed with aged Rye or Bourbon.

How to drink it

Dark amber in colour but without caramel in its formula, Cocchi Riserva La Venaria Reale is complex enough to be enjoyed by itself as a digestive, or over ice with a lemon peel.

Technical details

18% ABV

Bottle size: 50 cl

Ingredients: wine, sugar, alcohol, herbs infusion and spices.

The alcohol content makes this vermouth very robust and with an excellent preservation also after bottle is opened, if well tapped in the fridge.

Once open, keep chilled and drink within a month.
